1. Overview of our Activities in 2022

Our main activities conducted in 2022 were as follows:

- Children Center (“Jidokan”)

2. Activities in 2022

2.1 Children Center (“Jidokan”)

In 2022, we have successfully opened a children center (“Jidokan”): the place where Japanese children with the age 0 to 5 years old can play. The children are always accompanied by their parent. Most of the visitors of Jidokan are expats’ children and their mothers who have not been in the Netherlands that long. Jidokan functions not only as play place for the children, but also as information exchanges place for the mothers.

- Open every Wednesday from 13:00 – 16:00:
- Admission fee EUR 2:
- Expenses: Room rental fee of EUR 65 per time, tables and chairs for children (set up fee), stationaries, and travel expenses for volunteers.



2.2 ABBA Dance

After Jidokan, it is a time for elderly people. ABBA Dance is a group of elderly people, who want to enjoy doing physical exercise with ABBA music. At this moment, the members are only Japanese. However, we are also searching opportunities to get non-Japanese people involved.

- Started from March 2023:

- Open every Wednesday from 16:00 – 17:00
- The average number of participants per month in 2022 is seven (7).
- Admission fee EUR 2:
- Expenses: None (the room rental fee is covered by Jidokan).

2.4 Japanese Style Festival ("Bunkasai")
